TEMPORARY INCAPACITY (ART.37)

Temporary work disability (TI), also called **medical leave or work leave**, is the official recognition that a worker who contributes to Social Security cannot do their usual work due to a health problem. It generally entitles them to a financial benefit (subsidy).

We are talking about two different types of TI:

- · Work accident/Occupational disease.
- Non-work accident/Common disease.

The financial subsidy may vary depending on the situation or the length of the leave.

In our agreement, all workers in a situation of TI will receive the necessary supplement to reach 100% of their salary during the first three months. This also includes any salary increases produced during the period of leave

If you're still on a TI situation beyond the 3 months, you will be compensated at **100% by one more month for each three years** of continued service.
